27" x 33" (with no borders)

Supply list

Sewing machine-(straight stitching) cleaned, oiled and in good running
order

Sharpie Pen-extra fine black or a Micron Pigma Pen .05 or .08

Ballpoint pen, a few colored pencils, masking tape (thin)

Scissors: paper, fabric and a small sharp pair

Glass head silk pins 1 $\frac{3}{8}$ "

Freezer Paper –enough to cover the enlarged bear pattern

My sample bears are in brown and Miss Violet is purple dotted fabrics. You could
certainly make the bear in any color. Previous students have made him a polar
bear, red bear, pink bear, black bear and even K. Fasset fabrics bear.

Fabric for the Sky: 1 yard (more if it's a directional print)

Fabric for the Ground: 3 different $\frac{1}{4}$ yards (no fat quarters)

Fabric for the bear:

Quarter yards: (obviously the more fabric selection you can bring the
broader your options and choices for the value changes)

3-4 very light (nose and collar)

3-4 light (face)

4-5 medium light (face)

6-7 medium (face)

4-5 medium dark (body, ears)

3-4 darks (body and shadows)

toe nail fabric (stripe or fun print)

camera or iPad
