

# Pieced Landscapes Workshop: Plumeria Flower

18" x 18" without borders

INSTRUCTOR: **SUE RASMUSSEN**

Description: In this class we will work on a simple flower pattern, exploring color and fabric uses, design elements, and curved piecing techniques. This class is for beginner quilters with confidence (a little knowledge setting in sleeves to shoulders is very helpful), intermediate and advanced quilters.

## Plumeria Flower SUPPLY LIST

Landscape pattern, Plumeria Flower, supplied by instructor for \$12 includes of two enlarged copies

Background: Choose a color for your background (blue for example, but it could be any color) and bring 4 or 5 fat quarters or ¼ yards of different fabrics in that color similar in their value

Leaves: Choose three or four different fabrics, minimum of fat eighths

Flower: you may decide on one fabric for all the petals (about ¼ yard) or five different colors similar in color and values (fat eighths)

Bring a contrasting color for the center of the flower petals

Bring scraps for the small flower center

Sewing machine -cleaned and in good working order

Thread- matching background or flower or neutral tones

Fine or medium Pigma Micro Pens size .05 or .08, couple of colors if possible, or other marking tool which can be used on the *wax side* of freezer paper

Pencil/ball point pen; blue painters tape or masking tape

5 or 6 Colored pencils, markers *or* crayons

Fabric and paper scissors and one very sharp small pair for snipping curves

Freezer paper 18" wide and regular sewing supplies

Pins (1⅜" glass head silk pins 0.5mm diameter, often with white, red or blue heads)

Foam core board (at least 2' x 3' available at craft stores) or workshop walls if allowed at workshop site, iron and boards if not supplied by guild workshop

Optional: reducing glass, small binoculars or camera for viewing your project

Light box for tracing – very helpful if you have one
